Bennett had a Ph.D. in mathematics, and took a one-year course in computer science offered by Hood College (Maryland) and NBS. The goal of the program was to provide small colleges access to computers. Dr. Bennett went on to teach computer science and mathematics at Mount Saint Agnes College (now Loyola University Maryland) and the University of Baltimore.
